

GENERAL INFORMATION

The following materials are intended to provide helpful guidance to students and parents or guardians. The information, when combined with assistance from counselors, will enable students to plan their programs of study.

In selecting courses of study each student should consider:

1. Graduation requirements of Fairview High School.
2. Courses that will meet the student's future vocational and/or educational goals, and
3. Student's ability to do school work.

SCHEDULING REQUIREMENTS

Fairview has a four-period day. It is required that a student schedules four (4) periods per day each semester to obtain necessary credits for graduation.

Study halls will not be offered. A student who fails a required subject should include it on his/her course selection for the following semester or make plans to take it in summer school. For students enrolled in the college prep or honors curriculum a foreign language should be scheduled a minimum of two years but four years are suggested.

Counselors will assist each student individually to arrange a schedule as necessary. Students will discuss course selections with teachers and parents.

COURSE WITHDRAW / ADD POLICY

The following guidelines will be used in making schedule changes:

1. Schedule adjustments for all classes must be made within the first five days of the semester.
2. If a student withdraws from a class after the above stipulated time limit, the student will receive a grade of "F." This will appear on the permanent record and will be used for honor roll and class rank calculations.

NOTE: A student may not drop a course if it will result in fewer than the required four (4) credits minimum per semester.

NOTE: If a student withdraws from a course, he or she may not take the course in summer school.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Board requires that each student successfully complete a senior project.
