**Deadline** – Application must be postmarked no later than April 21, 2012 and sent to the Erie County Association of Township Officials, c/o Mr. Brian McGrath, Millcreek Township, 3608 West 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Erie, PA 16506. Scholarship recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Erie County Association of Township Officials.

**Notification of recipients** – Recipients will be notified by May 5, 2012. Unfortunately, due to the large volume of applicants, only successful scholarship recipients will be notified.

**Judging** – Applicants will be judged on exemplary community service, demonstrated community and school leadership, academic achievement and economic need, in that order.

**Residency requirement** – Applicants must reside in a Township in Erie County. Borough and City residents will not be considered.

**Application submission requirements** – *Incomplete applications will not be considered.* Applicants **must** submit all of the required information. Use the check off list below to insure a complete application.

- This application form--pages 1-3--typed or hand printed; signed; and notarized. The cover letter need not be returned.
- The applicant's high school transcript including the first two marking periods of the senior year.
- The applicant's SAT scores either shown on the high school transcript or a separate photocopy of the scores from the official SAT notification.
- A letter of recommendation from the guidance counselor written on high school stationery.
- Two additional letters of recommendation.
- A letter of acceptance from the college, university or school.
- A list or resume of school activities participated in by the applicant with offices held and honors received during high school years.
- A list or resume, with short descriptions, of the applicant's experiences in community service including church activities.
- An essay written by the applicant summarizing plans for education, future goals, and financial needs.
- A color picture of the applicant to be used for publicity purposes, which will not be returned
