CONTROVERSIAL ISSUES/CITIZENS' COMPLAINTS</p> <p>Citizens who have complaints and questions concerning the handling of controversial subject matter or materials should follow these procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">A. Confer with the teacher and building principal.B. If the matter is not resolved in 15 days, a complaint form should be filed with the office of the Superintendent. A hearing should be scheduled to resolve the issue.C. If the matter then is not resolved in the next 15 days, a request should be made to the Board Secretary to place the item on the agenda for the next regularly scheduled meeting. The decision of the Board will be rendered, in writing, to the interested parties.
