SEX EDUCATION</p> <p>Because of the school's commitment to the development of the child, a program of sex education is provided. The school's role is one of cooperation with the home in all phases of students' development.</p> <p>The program of sex education is conducted according to district guidelines regarding curriculum content, instructional materials, and the timetable of instruction approved by the Board.</p> <p>The district will notify parents/guardians that a program of sex education will be taught. No student is required to participate in sex education instruction. If a parent/guardian chooses to withdraw a child from sex education instruction, s/he must notify the principal in writing. An opportunity will be afforded to parents/guardians to examine the instructional materials to be used.</p> <p><u>Procedures</u></p> <p>Sex education shall be provided to students according to the following procedures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The principal shall notify the Superintendent prior to sending notices concerning sex education classes to the parents/guardians. 2. The principal shall notify, by district mailing, the parents/guardians of students involved in the district sex education classes. 3. This letter shall contain the course title, instructor(s) name, and a brief summary of course content. 4. The letter will also set a date, time and location for a parental meeting. This meeting shall be conducted by the principal and attended by the instructor(s). A more detailed explanation of course content will be given at that time.

5. At the conclusion of this meeting, the parents/guardians may sign a form, asking that their child not participate. Parents/Guardians not attending the meeting may secure this form from the office of the school involved. Those parents/guardians so choosing shall have their child assigned to another area while this class is being conducted.
