<p>1. Purpose/Authority</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">204.1. EXCUSED ABSENCES AND ALTERNATE EDUCATION</p> <p>The Board recognizes that there are times when out of school activities or alternate, equally rewarding educational experiences may be present; therefore, the administration is authorized to provide guidelines for these experiences; such as, student travel with parents and/or guardians, non-school district-sponsored educational trips, cooperative or work study programs under the guidance of certified professionals, participation in meritorious cultural, social, or political activities under the guidance of a certified professional.</p> <p>The Board also recognizes that certain other problems can occur which cause irregular attendance, such as personal illness or injury, death in family, impassable roads, and bona fide religious holidays; therefore, the administration is authorized to provide reasonable guidelines for excusing such students.</p> <p>In no way should the above policy be interpreted as exempting student(s) from the compulsory attendance provisions of the School Laws of Pennsylvania.</p>
