ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT</p> <p>The Board directs that the assignment of students to schools within this district be consistent with proper education of students and the best use of the resources of this district.</p> <p>The Board shall determine the school attendance areas of the district and shall expect each student to attend the school so designated. In assigning students to schools within this district, no distinction whatever shall be made on the basis of the student's race or color.</p> <p>The Superintendent will be required to make recommendations annually to the Board for the approval of the attendance areas within the district. All students shall be assigned or reasonably accommodated in one of the available buildings.</p> <p>The Board grants the administration the duty to assign students to those teachers and classes which in the administration's estimation would be most beneficial to the students.</p> <p>If after the initial assignment of a student to a class is made there is a need to transfer a student to a different class, this will be accomplished in consultation with the teachers involved. The administration will notify the teachers and parents/guardians of the transfer to take place prior to the actual transfer.</p> <p><u>Transfer</u></p> <p>Children who apply for admission to the district's schools by transfer from nonpublic schools or from schools outside the district will be placed initially on the grade level they would have reached elsewhere pending their observation and evaluation by classroom teachers, guidance personnel, and the school principal. After such observations and evaluations have been completed and the records received from the previous school district, the principal will determine the final grade placement of the children.</p>
