212. REPORTING PUPIL PROGRESS	
1. Purpose Pol. 216	The Board believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of the whole child. It recognizes its responsibility to keep parents informed of student welfare and progress in school. It also recognizes the effects of State Board regulations and Federal Regulations governing school records. (Pol. 216)
2. Authority	The Board directs the establishment of a system of reporting student progress which shall include written reports and parent conferences with teachers and shall require all appropriate staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility.

Delegation of Responsibility AP 212	<p>The Board directs the administration to develop and implement a system of regular reporting the progress of each student for the reporting period to the student's parents.</p> <p>This system will be reviewed and approved by the Board when changes are proposed.</p>
