222. USE OF TOBACCO	
<p>1. Purpose Act 168 of 1988 Act 145 of 1996</p>	<p>The Board recognizes that there is a problem of tobacco use by students of the Fairview School District and the Board further recognizes that the applicable Pennsylvania law prohibits tobacco use by students in school buildings and school vehicles and on indoor property owned by, leased by, or under the control of the school district.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 510</p>	<p>It shall be the policy of the Fairview School District that possession or use of tobacco by students is prohibited in school buildings and school buses and on school property owned by, leased by, or under the control of the Fairview School District. This prohibition shall apply during the normal school hours as well as public activities which might take place in school buildings and school buses and on school property owned by, leased by, or under the control of the Fairview School District at times other than normal school hours.</p>
<p>Title 18 Sec. 6306.1</p>	<p>The district shall initiate prosecution of any student who violates this policy. Any student violating this policy shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the benefit of the district, plus court costs, or be admitted to an adjudication alternative as authorized by state law.</p>
<p>3. Definitions Title 18 Sec. 6306.1</p>	<p>For the purpose of this policy, tobacco use shall include smoking and the use of smokeless tobacco in any form. For the purposes of this policy, smoking shall be defined to include possession of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or other lighted smoking equipment.</p> <p>For the purpose of this policy, tobacco shall be defined as a lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or other smoking product.</p>

<p>4. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The administration shall annually notify students and parents about the district's tobacco use policy by publishing such policy in the student handbook, district newsletter, and any other efficient means.</p> <p>The administration shall develop and implement such procedures as will prevent tobacco use among the students of the Fairview School District.</p>
