223. USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PARKING	
1. Authority SC 779	<p>Section 779 of the 1949 Public School Code of Pennsylvania, as amended, provides that the Board of School Directors of any school district may make rules and regulations not inconsistent with the provisions of the Vehicle Code or any local ordinance for the admission, control and movement of the vehicles and parking thereof on school property.</p> <p>The Board of School Directors has created the campus site for its elementary, middle and high schools located on land in the northeast corner of Route 98 and McCray Road in Fairview Township. Said campus for the elementary, middle and high schools has private roads and parking areas located thereon.</p> <p>The Board is desirous to provide the most efficient and safe means of control of vehicles on said school sites.</p>
SC 779 AP 223	<p>Therefore, in accordance with Section 779 of the Public School Code of 1949, as amended, the Board hereby enacts traffic regulations which will be set forth in AP 223. These regulations include the appropriate penalties for violations as set forth in sub-paragraph (b) of Section 779 of the Public School Code.</p>
2. Delegation of Responsibility AP 223, 223.1	<p>The administration shall develop and implement an administrative procedure for student driving and parking regulations during school hours.</p>
