CHEMICALS AND/OR SUBSTANCES</p> <p>The Fairview Board of School Directors realizes there is a potential danger to the education and health of its students by the misuse of chemicals and/or substances. The Board, therefore, directs the administration to develop and implement appropriate procedures for preventing the misuse of chemicals and/or substances by students on school property and at all school functions.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>PROHIBITION OF ANABOLIC STEROIDS</u></p> <p>Eligibility for participation in school athletics shall be limited. No student shall be eligible to resume participation in school athletics unless there has been a medical determination that no residual evidence of steroids exists. The Board may require participation in any drug counseling, rehabilitation, testing or other programs as a condition of reinstatement into a school athletic program.</p> <p>The use of steroids by students involved in athletics is prohibited. In addition to the prohibition of use, the Board directs the administration to develop educational plans regarding the use of anabolic steroids.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall prescribe, implement and enforce rules and regulations to prohibit the use of anabolic steroids, except for a valid medical purpose, by any student involved in school-related athletics. Body building and muscle enhancement of athletic ability are not valid medical purposes. Human Growth Hormone (HGH) shall not be included as an anabolic steroid under the provisions of the law.</p> <p>Education regarding the dangers of anabolic steroids shall be provided in other district drug and alcohol programs.</p> <p>The following minimum penalties are prescribed for any student found in violation of the rules and regulations required above. Violation of rules and regulations include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For a first violation, suspension from school athletics for the remainder of the season.
