| 1. Purpose | The Board recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events. |
| 2. Authority | <p>The Board endorses such performances when they constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school; and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety and well-being of the students who will be involved.</p> <p>All requests for public performances by student groups require the approval of the Board of School Directors.</p> |
| SC 511 | <p>Although cognizant of the values, both social and scholastic, derived by pupils participating in various community sponsored activities, the following points should be used by principals in determining whether or not pupils may participate in such activities during school hours:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The participation in the project will not deprive students of time needed in acquiring basic skills. 2. The regular schedule will not be interrupted unless the majority of the students benefit through their participation. 3. Neither an individual nor the school as a whole shall be permitted to use school time in working on community sponsored projects unless such an undertaking is contributing to the educational program. 4. Pupils may participate in various community sponsored activities during school hours only with the permission of the principal. |
| 3. Delegation of Responsibility | <p>The Superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy which require that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parental permission is sought and received before students may participate. |
