



Exceptions

1. Weapons under the control of law enforcement personnel or security personnel are permitted.
2. Possession of weapons or firearms in conjunction with any intramural, interscholastic, or extracurricular activity sponsored by the District and under the supervision of District authorized personnel shall be permitted, subject to the approval and authorization of the Superintendent.
3. The Superintendent may prescribe special conditions or procedures to be followed before giving authorization for possession of weapons or firearms on school property, at any school-sponsored activity or on any public conveyance providing transportation to a school or school-sponsored activity, and such possession shall be subject to special authorization for each individual incident of possession.
4. A weapon or firearm that is unloaded and is possessed by an individual while traversing school property for the purpose of obtaining access to public or private lands used for lawful hunting is permitted, if the entry on school premises is authorized by school authorities.

Ramifications and Penalties

5. Incidents of students possessing weapons, firearms or destructive devices, including replicas thereof, in violation of this Policy will be reported to the parents and/or guardians.

Additionally, the school Superintendent or chief administrator shall report the discovery of possession of any weapon, firearm or destructive device to local law enforcement officials.

6. The school Superintendent or chief administrator shall report to the Department of Education all incidents relating to expulsions for possession of a weapon, firearm or destructive device on school grounds, school-sponsored activities or public conveyances providing transportation to a school or school-sponsored activity.
7. Appropriate disciplinary and/or legal action may be taken against students who possess weapons, firearms or destructive devices in violation of this policy and against students who assist in such possession in any way.
