<p>1. Purpose SC 1106</p> <p>SC 1124</p>	<p>It is the responsibility of the Board to provide the administrative staff necessary for the implementation of the educational program for the children of the district and for the proper operation of the schools, and to do so efficiently and economically consistent with the needs of the district.</p> <p>The Board recognizes its responsibility to maintain administrative staff positions consistent with the needs of the district.</p>
<p>2. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent shall recommend to the Board annually the number of administrative positions needed for the district to function efficiently and shall be responsible for recommending the abolishment of unnecessary positions.</p>
<p>3. Guidelines</p> <p>Pol. 311</p> <p>School Code 524, 1124</p> <p>PA Statute Act 353 of 1968</p> <p>Board Policy 311</p>	<p>The abolishment of administrative positions may be brought about by many facts, such as decline in student enrollment and/or changes in the organization structure of the district.</p> <p>Reduction in staff as a result of the abolishment of positions shall be in accordance with law and the procedures set forth in Board Pol. 311.</p>
