



3. Do not use school time for outside activities when there is no valid reason to be excused from assigned duties.
4. Refrain from making public statements about private associations or interests during school hours, if such remarks are likely to violate community standards of propriety.
5. Refrain from making public statements that are inconsistent with district policies and that could serve to harm the effectiveness of district programs.
6. Neither professional nor service personnel shall be engaged in the selling of any type of merchandise, e.g. books, maps, stationery, to the school district, nor shall they, in any way, be involved in the selling of merchandise to students or district employees during the school day.
7. A teacher may not present medals or other prizes, which are offered by commercial firms, to the pupils without permission of the Superintendent.
