908. RELATIONS WITH PARENTS	
1. Purpose	The Board believes that the education of children is a joint responsibility, one it shares with the parents of the school community. To insure that the best interests of the child are served in this process, a strong program of communication between home and school must be maintained.
2. Authority SC 1317	The Board feels that it is the parents who have the ultimate responsibility for their children's in school behavior, including the behavior of pupils who have reached the legal age of majority but are still, for all practical purposes, under parental authority. During school hours, the Board, through its designated administrators, acts in loco parentis or in place of the parents.
3. Guidelines	<p>The Board encourages the formation and operation of PTA/PTO organizations within the school district at the building level.</p> <p>Similar community school groups with high educational goals are also welcomed to assist the district. The Board has the right to determine which community groups may function within the school district. The Superintendent is encouraged to meet regularly with representatives of these associations.</p> <p>The administration shall develop procedures and guidelines to implement this policy.</p>
AP 908	Meetings by various student groups which are school district sponsored shall be open to the public; therefore, the administration has developed guidelines which do not deny citizens the knowledge of their children's activities, but do not interfere with the educational purpose of the activity.
