909. MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT RELATIONS	
1. Purpose	It is the policy of the Board that this Board, school officials, and municipal officials maintain a close and harmonious association. Such liaison is requisite for dealing with school/community matters and problems in the most satisfactory manner and assuring the most prudent expenditure of tax dollars.
2. Authority Art. III Sec. 14	The Board recognizes that its authority arises directly from the General Assembly, but it also is aware that the municipality and the school district must work together for the welfare of the citizens.
3. Responsibility	<p>The Board, as an independent body, has no statutory relationship to other local governmental bodies. It will, however, cooperate with other governing agencies, both educational and civic, to achieve the goal of all governmental bodies, namely the best interests of the youth and the citizens of the Fairview area.</p> <p>While the Board will maintain complete autonomy at all times, it will in cases where it deems it in the best interest of the youth and taxpayers of the district to work cooperatively with the agencies in the community.</p> <p>Educational programs designed to make the youth of our schools sensitive to the need for and the practice of good safety habits will be sponsored jointly by the school district and the various fire and police departments. The school staff and the administrators are urged to cooperate with personnel of such departments in every possible way.</p>
