	<b>910. COMMUNITY RELATIONS</b>
1. Purpose	<p>The Board of School Directors feels it imperative that communication be maintained in both directions between the public schools of the district and local institutions, organizations and groups such as industry, business, labor, charity and other special interests which make up the structure of the community.</p>
2. Authority	<p>The Board of School Directors recognize their responsibility to listen and respond to comments and suggestions from the residents of the school district.</p> <p>Recognizing that a Board member as an individual cannot speak for, or in the name of, the total Board, individual Board members will refer compliments, suggestions and constructive criticism about operational matters directly to the Superintendent for appropriate consideration, action, or referral to the Board President.</p> <p>Policy concerns will be referred to the Chairperson of the Policy Committee and to the Superintendent.</p> <p><u>Participation in Community Life/Volunteerism</u></p> <p>District employees are encouraged to be involved in community life and volunteer activities. Activities requiring released time from school duties requires the approval of the building principal and Superintendent. This time is to be made-up at the discretion of the building principal.</p> <p><u>Relations Between Public and School Personnel</u></p> <p>The Board encourages school personnel to maintain a cooperative and professional manner toward the public; always mindful of their position and responsibility to the children of the community.</p>
